In order not to delay this submittal of information to the Commission in connection with the review of the application of leak-before-break methodology to the Comanche Peak pressurizer surge line, we will comply with the requirements to 10CFR2.790 to provide proprietary and non-proprietary versions together with an affidavit as soon as the proprietary information contained in the submittal has been specifically identified and the proprietary and non-proprietary versions have been prepared. We will submit the total required number of copies of the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information and the required affidavit at that time.

In the meantime, we have provided sufficient copies for you to initiate your review. E. Shomaker, Esq., of the NRC Office of the General Counsel, has advised Westinghouse that he concurs with this procedure.

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
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We expect to be able to fully comply with the requirements for the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information and an accompanying affidavit within four weeks.
