

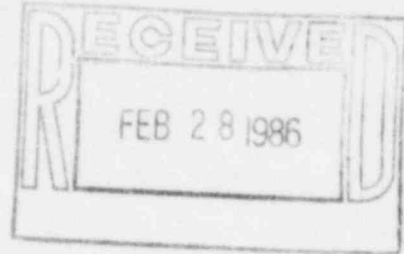

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 6, 1986, we verbally notified your Mr. S. Phillips of a deficiency regarding improper welding processes in the manufacturing of cable tray "tee" fittings which could affect the equipment qualification. This is an interim report of a potentially reportable item under the provisions of 10CFR50.55(e). The qualification of trays is directly related to the design verification efforts assigned to Ebasco and Impell. The evaluation of this concern will be included within this verification program which is scheduled for completion in June 1986.

We are continuing our evaluation and anticipate completion of our final report by July 1, 1986.
