In accordance with Generic Letter No. 87-07 and the guidance given in NUREG-1262, this letter is being submitted to certify that the Licensed Operator Training Program (initial and requalification) is based on a systems approach to training and is accredited by the National Academy of Nuclear Training. The initial accreditation of the training program took place in January 1984. The new training program, which incorporated revisions required by changes to 10CFR50.55, was audited by the National Academy of Nuclear Training in January 1988. The current program supersedes the previously existing NRC-approved training program.
