SEACOAST ANTI-POLLUTION LEAGUE'S ANSWERS TO THE APPLICANTS' FIRST SET OF INTERROGATORIES REGARDING THE SPMC AND MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

- 1) Jane Doughty, SAPL's Field Director, is the respondent providing the answers to these interrogatories. SAPL's business address is SAPL, 5 Market Street, Portsmouth, N.H. 03801.
- 2) SAPL is in possession of no documents responsive to this interrogatory. The conversations SAPL has had relative to the subject matters described in this interrogatory have been with counsel to the various parties to this proceeding and are, therefore, deemed privileged. Conversations with town officials have been in the presence of their counsel and are also deemed privileged. The only other conversations outside of the above-described have been with Bill Lord, Chairman of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Amesbury. Those

conversations have generally been in the nature of poking fun at the idea that utility workers could adequately perform functions required in a local community emergency response and have revolved around the basic theme that the SPMC is not going to work to adequately protect the Town of Amesbury's citizens.

- 3) All conversations referred to in this interrogatory related to opposing Seabrook Station's licensing have been with counsel to this proceeding and are therefore deemed privileged.
- 4) SAPL has no knowledge of any such documents.
- 5) For purposes of reducing the length of the listing, SAPL will provide the contentions it may litigate. They are SAPL contentions Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 11, MA AG contentions 26, 48, 54 and 55, NECNP Contention No. 5 and Town of Salisbury Contention 19.
- 6) (a) Insofar as SAPL knows, the facts underlying the assertions in these contentions are set forth in the bases of the contentions.
 - (b) SAPL can speak with any knowledge only to the sources of the facts in the contentions SAPL drafted. Those facts were all drawn from information contained in the SPMC except for additional facts in SAPL Contention No. 2 which were learned from Ashod N. Amirian, Esquire, the

Assistant City Solicitor for the City of Haverhill, 376 Main Street, Haverhill, MA 01830.

- (c) No expert witnesses have yet been chosen.
- (d) No non-expert witnesses have yet been chosen.
- (e) SAPL has no documents and no calculations apart from those in the contention bases.
