Dear Ms. Curran:

This is in further response to your letter dated November 16, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), five categories of documents and information related to NUREG/CR-3597, SAND 84-0938, RV; NUREG/CR-3418, SAND 83-1617, RV; and Board Notification 84-032.

Documents 2, 3, 5, and 6, and portions of the remaining documents listed on the enclosed Appendix H are being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (4) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) of the Commission's regulations. The records being withheld in whole or in part contain confidential business (proprietary) information. The disclosure of the withheld information could result in harm to the competitive positions of the owners. The nonexempt portions of documents 1, 4, 7, and 8 are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), located at 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC, in file folder FOIA-84-863 under your name.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. James M. Taylor, Director, Office of Inspection and Enforcement.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."
