SUBJECT: NRC BULLETIN 88-01, MPA B-100, "DEFECTS IN WESTINGHOUSE CIRCUIT BREAKERS" (TAC NO. 67683)

On February 5, 1988, NRC Bulletin 88-01 was issued and requested holders of operating licenses or construction permits to provide letters of confirmation to the NRC of the completion of specified inspections on Westinghouse DS series circuit breakers. Addressees who do not have DS series circuit breakers in Class 1E service were requested to provide a letter to the NRC stating this fact.

Your response of April 8, 1988 confirmed that Westinghouse DS series circuit breakers are not used in safety-related applications at Limerick Units 1 and 2. Thus, your response to Bulletin 88-01 is satisfactory and no further reply is necessary.

For purposes of the Safety Issues Management System (SIMS), MPA B-100 is being recorded both as fully implemented and verified as of the date of this letter.
