The attached report by our fieid inspector of a visit to the subject facility on March 11, 1969 is forwarded for information. No items of noncorapliance or of safety significance were noted during tbe visit.

Based on our observations and information obtained from the applicant personnel, the tentative schedule for the start of construction of the containment building appears to be reasonable forecast. Also, of interest, was an obvious awareness on the part of the applicant personnel $O_{i}^{*}$ the stress expected to be plsced on quality assurance and quality control programs.

You will note that PGSE's specifications for the tensile testing of Cadweld splices in the concrete reinforaing steel calls for a lesser number of splices to be tested than are suggested in the RTM which covers this subject. However, in view of the (internal) classification of RTMs, the discrepancy was not discussed with the PGsiE representatives.
