10 minutes. Written statements that may be submitted are unlimited as to length. Both kinds of statements, which are not made under oath, will be included in the record of the proceeding but do not constitute evidence.

The time designated for making limited appearances is between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. on March 12. To accommodate those who may appear on the first day of the hearing and wish to make a limited appearance, the hour following the luncheon recess on March 11 has been set aside. Should other additional limited appearance sessions be required, other times will be designated.

Wednesday afternoon, March 12, has been set aside for a visit to the facility site.

The proceeding will commence with Contention 7, to be followed by Contentions 10.5 and 10.1. The order of presentation of evidence will be Applicant, Intervenors and then Staff.
