Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to provide the special circumstances per $10 \ \text{CFR}$ 50.12 (a) (2) ii that warrant granting the requested test exemption (Reference a).

As indicated by the Reactor Duilding Integrated Leakage Rate Test (ILRT) Report submitted to the NRC on January 25. 1985, the performance of a short duration (8 hours) ILRT (Type A-Periodic) will satisfy the underlying purpose of 10 CFR 50 Appendix J. Section III.A.3(a). Although the January 25. 1988 test report was based upon a 24 hour period, satisfactory results were obtained after the initial 8 hours.

If the 24 hour duration test is performed, the Mass Point Analysis technique of ANSI 56.8-1981 will satisfy the underlying purpose of 10 CFR 50 Appendix J, Section III.A.3(a).
