Gentlemen:

A signed original and ten (10) copies of the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 2 Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) have been forwarded in accordance with 10 CFR 50.71(e). Additional copies are being provided to the Region I office and Resident Inspector.

To our best judgement and ability, this revision accurately presents changes necessary to reflect information and analyses submitted to the Commission or prepared pursuant to Commission requirements. This includes changes identified in the most recent "Report of Facility Changes, Tests and Experiments" which is submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.59. All changes in this revision, which are subject to 10 CFR 50.59, were included in that submittal. Editorial changes intended to correct or clarify the text of the Updated FSAR are also included in this revision.

The Final Safety Analysis Report Quality Assurance Program description (FSAR, Appendix A) has been revised to reflect changes in Duquesne Light Company's management structure and to reflect current Quality Assurance Unit practices. These changes have been reviewed against the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3) and it has been determined that the changes do not reduce the commitments in the QA program description previously accepted by the NRC. In addition, since the Operations QA Program is common to both BVPS-1 and BVPS-2, the BVPS-2 program description has been supplemented with information from the BVPS-1 UFSAR. The BVPS-1 UFSAR will later be revised to delete the redundant material and will incorporate the BVPS-2 program description by reference.
