A summary of the generating unit's status and significant analytical results is provided below. The unit was shutdown for refueling during July. All sampled water sources were found to be within permit limits, except one chlorination on 7/6/88 which exceeded limits. The chlorination was stopped when the sample indicated excessive chlorine. The chemical pumps were reset and testing the following day was within limits. This incident occurred with only two of the four circulating pumps running. Procedural changes have been made to prevent future reoccurrence. Pursuant to Order No. 85-13, Reporting Requirement 12, your letter dated June 25, 1985, authorizes the following representative(s) to sign and certify all reports required by this order: Arthur Kneisel, Environmental Engineer.
