
This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act, as amended.

I would like to receive a copy of any and all papers delivered at the International Meeting on Reduced Enrichment for Research and Test Reactors held October 14-16, 1985 in Petten, The Netherlands, and which are in the possession of NRC.

The Committee to Bridge the Gap is a non-profit public interest organization which has been actively involved in the development of NRC's rule curbing the use of highly enriched uranium. We are tax-exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the tax code. The requested documents will be used in our ongoing research on conversion of non-power reactors to low enriched uranium fuels.
