This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. R. E. Farrell of this office during the period January 1-31, 1986, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License DPR-34 for Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Generating Station, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. J. W. Gahm and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included operational safety verification, review of licensee event reports, training accreditation with INPO, I&E Notice 85-100 (Rosemount transmitters), ESF-circulator break and seal remote actuation, and water ingress incident. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. These findings are documented in the enclosed report.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.
