## ORDER

On February 25, 1986, the applicants filed their response to the motion of intervenor Ohio Citizens for Responsible Energy to reopen the record on the question of the adequacy of the seismic design of the Perry nuclear facility.<sup>1</sup> A number of attachments accompanied the response.

An examination of Attachment 5 has disclosed that several of the figures included in it are unacceptable. More specifically:

Figures 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 38 and 39 are unintelligible in significant part.

Figures 26, 27 and 28 have legends which, at least in part, are unintelligible.

Figures 35, 36 and 37 have no identifying legends at all.

Accordingly, the foregoing figures in Attachment 5 are <u>stricken sua sponte</u>. If they so desire, the applicants may move for leave to resubmit the figures with the noted infirmities corrected. Any such motion, together with the corrected figures, must be in our hands <u>no later than</u>

March 24, 1986.
