CONTENTION 1: As a matter of law and fact, Baltimore Gas & Electric

Company's (BGE) license renewal application to operate

Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CNPP) Unit 1 and Unit 2

is incomplete and must be withdrawn and/or summarily

dismissed.

As a matter of law, this Board must apply those binding regulations. <u>Union Electric Co. v. FERC</u>, 890 F.2d 1193, 1199 (D.C. Cir. 1989). The filing of these two contentions is without prejudice to the Center's right to file additional supplemental contentions on or prior to the 15th day before the first prehearing conference.
