SUBJECT: ACCIDENTAL CONSTRUCTION FATALITY

A Georgia Power Company construction employee suffered fatal injuries March 3, 1986 when he fell 40 feet down an elevator shaft in the turbine building. The man was pronounced dead on arrival at the Talmadge Memorial Hospital in Augusta, Georgia.

The employee was attempting to open the elevator door when it suddenly opened.

The licensee has been responding to media inquiries.

The State of Georgia and the federal Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) have been informed.

The NRC (Region II) received initial notification of this event by telephone from the resident inspector on March 3 at 3:40 p.m.
