SUBJECT: LEAK REDUCTION PROGRAM - LICENSE COMMITMENT 15 OF SECTION 1B OF USAR (UPDATED SAFETY ANALYSIS REPORT) FOR THE PERRY NUCLEAR PLANT UNIT 1 (TAC NO. 69180)

In response to TMI Action Plan Item III.D.1.1, "Integrity of Systems Outside Containment Likely to Contain Radioactive Material for Pressurized-Water Reactors and Boiling-Water Reactors," licensees were required to implement a program to reduce leakage from systems outside containment that would or could contain highly radioactive fluids during a serious accident or transient to as low as practical levels. The NRC staff's acceptance of the leak reduction program for Perry Unit 1 is documented in Supplemental Safety Evaluation Report (SSER) No. 8 dated January 1986, Section 11.5. This program was required (as committed to by you in the USAR under License Condition No. 15) to be implemented prior to full power operation.

On June 28, 1987 you transmitted the results of your leakage reduction program of potential primary coolant sources outside containment. The results of your tests indicate a total leakage rate of 0 standard cubic centimeters per minute (SCCM) air for components outside containment and not included in the secondary containment bypass leakage rate surveillance and a total leakage rate of less than 5.0 gallons per hour (GPH) liquid for systems and components outside the secondary containment which could carry primary coolant after a serious transient or accident.

Based upon our review of your test results, we conclude that you have adequately met the acceptance criteria for this item and, therefore, we consider this item closed for your facility. We further conclude that you have acceptably fulfilled

your commitments as described in License Condition 15 of the USAR. This completes our review effort under TAC No. 69180.
