

Dear Stewart, Bernie, and Don:

On February 20, 1986, Tip Letsche wrote to you requesting documents pertaining to the February 13 exercise. A copy of Tip's letter is enclosed. We have received no response to Tip's letter.

I hereby request that you promptly respond and provide the requested documents. These documents, together with the FEMA report which is being prepared, are essential to the Governments' review of the exercise. This particularly is the case because the information which the Governments were able to derive by monitoring parts of the exercise and attending FEMA's post-exercise meetings was limited and incomplete. We need complete details of what in fact occurred and what the intended "exercise scenario" was in order to assess the exercise results.
