

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p), please find attached the signed original and three (3) copies of Revision 25, to the Oconee Nuclear Station Security Plan. Revision 25 was developed to address physical barriers in subterranean Protected Area (PA) penetrations, several table clarifications and inspection of Protected Areas (PA's) and Vital Areas (VA's).
