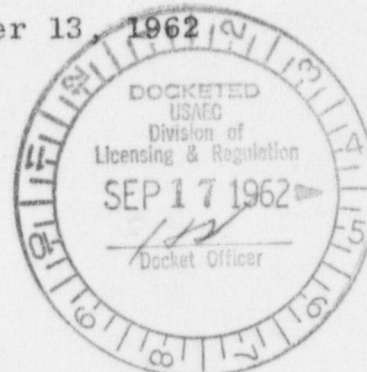

Dear Mr. Nussbaumer:

This letter is in reference to Source Material License number SUA-547 which applies to our Monumel. Concentrator uranium operation.

For the purpose of complying with Section 20.102(b) of 10 CFR 20, we request that the limits given in Appendix B, Table 1 of this part be deemed to apply to exposure to the concentrations specified for 160 hours in any period of 28 consecutive days. In any such period where the number of hours of exposure is less than 160 hours, the limits specified in the Table may be increased proportionately. In any such period where the number of hours of exposure is greater than 160 hours, the limits specified in the Table shall be decreased proportionately.
