2. Physical Protection of Safeguards Information

The inspector reviewed the licensee procedures and records, interviewed personnel, and visually examined Safeguards Information (SGI) repositories to determine whether the licensee's program for the protection of Safeguards Information meets the general performance requirements of 10 CFR 73.21. The inspector's review encompassed the types of information being protected, physical protection (in-use and in-storage), markings, access, reproduction, destruction, and external transmissions, including automatic data processing systems.

The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements in the areas inspected.
