1. Provide additional details describing the design features incorporated in the Main Feedwater Systems of both units, and operational procedures that would be followed to minimize the occurrence of water hammer in the piping system. An acceptable level of detail on this issue is contained in Attachments F and G to a letter from D. E. Swartz, Commonwealth Edison to H. R. Denton, NRC, "Byron Station, Units 1 & 2 - Elimination of Arbitrary Intermediate Pipe Breaks," dated November 15, 1985.
