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NRC EVALUATION OF PILGRIM EMERGENCY OPERATING PROCEDURES

In response to your February 5, 1988 letter, Boston Edison will be prepared to support your staff's onsite evaluation of the new Pilgrim Station Emergency Operating Procedures (EOPs) on any date convenient to you on or following February 22, 1988. Based on a February 11, 1988 telephone conversation, we understand March 14, 1988 is convenient for the NRC.

By February 22, 1988 the EOPs will be validated, and one operating crew will be certified on them. Two operating crews will be certified by March 7, 1988. These crews will provide trained operators for your staff to interview. A third crew will be in training the week of March 14, 1988 which your staff can observe in simulator exercises of EOPs.
