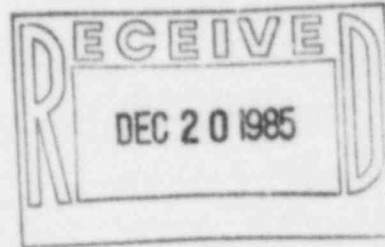

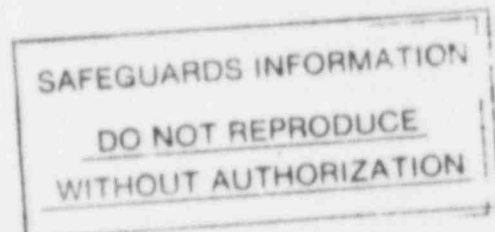
Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is written in response to your letter of November 15, 1985, which transmitted Inspection Report STN 50-482/85-27. As requested, the violation (482/8527-01) identified in the Inspection Report is being addressed in four parts which are presented in Attachment A.

- a) The reason for the violation, if admitted;
- b) The corrective steps which have been taken and results achieved;
- c) The corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and
- d) The date when full compliance will be achieved.

As stated in your November letter, the corrective action in response to violation 482/8527-02 has been implemented and found to be acceptable by the NRC inspector and, therefore, no additional response is required.


