Gentlemen -

A 23 year reader of the N.H. Seacoast,
I write to add my voice to the many local
citizens' who oppose a rule change that would
remove requirements for effective public warning
systems before low power testing at Seabrook Station.

Such a rule(s) change would be clearly
prejudicial in the continuing and on-going debate
about the licensing of Seabrook Station, - the more
especially so in view of the N.R.C. position taken
at the start of the organization along Seabrook (ie of
the Six Mile River Meeting) when the subject of warnings
was broached by local opponents of the nuclear power
project and the N.R.C. granted testing and (then)
construction permits while promising to hold the
