Gentlemen -

A 23 year resident of the N.H. Seaboard,  
I write to add my voice to the many local  
citizens' who oppose a rule change that would  
remove requirements for effective public hearing  
systems before low power hearing at Seaboard Station.

Such a rule(s) change would be clearly  
prejudicial in the continuing and on-going debate  
about the licensing of Seaboard Station, - the more  
especially so in view of the N.R.C. position taken  
at the start of the negotiation about Seaboard (i.e. at  
the Site Evaluation Hearings) when the subject of concerns  
was broached by local opponents of the nuclear power  
project and the N.R.C. granted hearing and (then)  
construction permits while promising to hold the

power subject to strict public safety standards  
AT A LATER DATE. This year date is now.

And a change in the rules now can be  
understood generally as only a relaxation  
of the N.R.C. guarantee at the time of
