SUBJECT: HEART ATTACK AT VOGTLE SITE

An electrician employed by Catalytic Industrial Maintenance Company, a Georgia Power Company contractor, had a heart attack at the Vogtle site at 8:00 a.m. (EST) on September 16, 1988. This occurred outside the plant protected area near the cooling towers. He was transported by the site ambulance to the Burke County Hospital and was pronounced dead on arrival. The worker was in his mid-fifties. Georgia Power Company does not plan a press release.

The State of Georgia was informed.
