Gentlemen:

We have received your submittal of Revision 7B to the Quad Cities Station Annex to the Generating Stations Emergency Plan. We have completed our review of Revision 7B, dated August 1988, and have determined that it is consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 5.054(q) and does not decrease the effectiveness of the Emergency Plan.

The Annex revision includes additional and reformatted data from the Evacuation Time Estimate study, previously done for the Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ). A revised figure also indicates that the entire cities of Clinton and LeClaire, Iowa are in the EPZ. These changes are consistent with those made to offsite emergency plans in response to FEMA Region VII concerns.

Be advised that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires prior NRC approval of any changes to your plan which may decrease the effectiveness of the plan. However, if your safety review assures no decrease in emergency preparedness effectiveness, then changes to the plan may be made and implemented without prior NRC approval in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Also, any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
