UPDATE TO LETTER CONCERNING INITIATIVES FOR IDENTIFYING AND  
CORRECTING FSAR DISCREPANCIES**

Gentlemen:

The referenced letter described various voluntary initiatives that were being performed to identify and correct FSAR discrepancies. Two of the initiatives listed, "FSAR Review by System Engineers," and "FSAR Question and Response (Q&R) Reviews," were scheduled to be completed by October 18, 1998. The Systems Engineer review, which reviewed the applicable FSAR sections within the responsibility of the systems engineers to reconfirm that the FSAR descriptions are consistent with the as-built configuration and design documentation, has been completed and FSAR corrections are in progress as necessary.

The Q&R review, which reviewed selected Q&Rs to assure that they had been correctly incorporated into the updated FSAR, is still ongoing. To date, the reviews for 75% of the Q&Rs have been completed and corrections initiated as necessary. However, due to a heavier than anticipated work schedule, and in light of EGM 98-07 "Extension of Exercise of Discretion for FSAR Discrepancies Identified While the Licensee has a Defined Program for Identifying Such Discrepancies," issued September 15, 1998, the completion date for the remaining Q&Rs has been extended until April 1, 1999.


