Dear Mr. Davis:

Illinois Power Company (IP) letter U-601095, dated December 4, 1987, provided scheduled completion dates for annunciator work identified as of December 1, 1987 at Clinton Power Station. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this work was completed as scheduled.

The eighteen dicabled and twenty out of service annunciators were cleared from the annunciator log prior to the completion of the spring 1988 maintenance outage. Alterations required as of December 1, 1987 to ensure that twenty-two annunciators are not illuminated during normal plant operations were field complete during the first quarter of 1988 as scheduled.

Completion of this work has resulted in a substantial decrease in the number of lit annunciators in the Control Room. IP is continuing to work toward a goal of operating with a "black board."
