SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING WITH SOUTH CAROLINA ELECTRIC & GAS COMPANY

## General

On September 1, 1988, the NRC staff, consisting of representatives of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, met with the South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G) to discuss the status of the licensing issues for the V.C. Summer Nuclear Station. The meeting was held at the offices of NRC in Rockville, Maryland A list of those persons who attended the meeting is included as Enclosure 1.

## Discussion

A handout was provided at the meeting which provided the NRC's current assessment of the status of various licensing actions. This handout is included as Enclosure 2. Discussion focused on those licensing actions required for the refueling outage which is to begin on September 16, 1988. A discussion was also held on the licensee's proposed response to NRC Bulletin 88-08, "Thermal Stresses in Piping Connected to Reactor Coolant Systems." The licensee discussed their preliminary findings and their intended actions during the next refueling outage scheduled for September 16, 1988 through December 1, 1988.

The next meeting is currently scheduled for October 18, 1988 at the V. C. Summer Station.
