MRC STAFF MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE TO INTERVENORS' GENERAL EXERCISE CONTENTIONS

The NRC Staff hereby moves the Licensing Board pursuant to 10 C.F.R. \$2.711 and 10 C.F.R. § 2.730 for an extension of time from October 3, 1988 to October 13, 1988 to file its response to the general exercise contentions filed by the Massachusetts Attorney General, SAPL, NECNP, and the Town of Hampton. The Staff's motion is grounded on the volume and complexity of the proposed general exercise contentions and the Staff's personnel limitations, which together make it unrealistic for the Staff to adequately respond to the Intervenors' contentions by the current deadline.
