Dear Gentlemen:

This letter acknowledges receipt of the Notice of Violations dated May 12, 1983 resulting from Inspection Report 50-440/88005 dated May 6, 1988. The report identified areas examined by Mr. D. M. Galanti and Ms. G. M. Christoffer during their inspection conducted from April 4-3, 1988 of activities at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1. Our responses to Notice of Violations 50-440/88005-1, 2, and 3 are attached.

Additionally, the report details identified corrective actions concerning the protected area perimeter terrain. Your understanding of those corrective actions appears to be correct. However, due to material procurement restraints the overall completion date must be extended to August 31, 1988. Interim corrective actions already implemented are sufficient to address the concern, thus there is no significance to extending the completion date.
