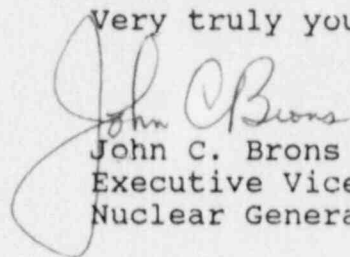
In accordance with 10 CFR 170.12, a check for \$150.00 is enclosed as payment of the application fee for the review of these proposed changes to the Technical Specifications.
