Reference: LP&L letter W3P88-1246 dated 7/18/88, from R.F. Burski to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission

In the referenced letter, Louisiana Power & Light stated that a further investigation of the compatibility of Mobil Temp SHC-32 and Chevron SRI-2 greases for our Containment Cooling Fan Motors will be completed by October 1, 1988. As discussed with the NRC Resident Inspector, personnel changes in the Equipment Qualification Staff, including the resignation of the engineer performing the evaluation, have prevented LP&L from meeting the October 1, 1988 milestone.

Although the milestone above will be delayed until December 31, 1988, LP&L still expects to be in full compliance by the date specified in the referenced letter.
