Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission or NRC), has issued Facility Operating License No. NPF-45 to the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Duquesne Light Company, Ohio Edison Company, Pennsylvania Power Company and the Toledo Edison Company (licensees) which authorizes operation of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1 (the facility), at reactor core power levels not in excess of 3579 megawatts thermal in accordance with the provisions of the License, the Technical Specifications and the Environmental Protection Plan with a condition limiting operation to five percent of full power (178 megawatts thermal). Authorization to operate beyond five percent of full power will require specific Commission approval.

Perry Unit 1 is a boiling water reactor located near Lake Erie in Lake County, Ohio, approximately 35 miles northeast of Cleveland, Ohio.

The license is effective as of the date of issuance. The application for the license complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's regulations. The

Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I which are set forth in the License. Prior public notice of the overall action involving the proposed issuance of an operating license was published in the Federal Register on February 13, 1981 (46 FR 12372).

The Commission has determined that the issuance of this License will not result in any environmental impacts other than those evaluated in the Final Environmental Statement since the activity authorized by the license is encompassed by the overall action evaluated in the Final Environmental Statement.
