Mississippi Power and Light (MP&L) is submitting by this letter additional information regarding a proposed change dated November 14, 1985 (AECM-85/0360). This proposal supplements and modifies that part of the previously proposed change to the Operating License dealing with Operating License Condition 2.C.(28). A notice on the significant hazards considerations of the previously proposed change was published in the Federal Register on December 3, 1985. Because the intent and content of this proposed modification are essentially unchanged with regard to significant hazards considerations, MP&L believes the December 3, 1985 Federal Register notice suffices to meet the requirements of 10CFR50.91.

Also submitted by this letter are two additional changes to the Grand Gulf Technical Specifications which results from design changes planned to be implemented during the first refueling outage.

As done on several recent Technical Specification changes involving design changes to the plant, it is requested that the NRC issue the changes with an open effective date and require that MP&L notify the NRC within 30 days of the effective date of implementation of the affected technical specification change. These design changes are scheduled for implementation no later than startup following the first refueling outage.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.30, three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of the requested amendment are enclosed. The attachment provides the complete technical justification and discussion to support the requested amendment. This amendment has been reviewed and accepted N # 02-012 by the Plant Safety Review Committee (PSRC) and the Safety Review Committee (SRC).

Based on the guidelines presented in 10 CFR 50.92, it is the opinion of MP&L that this proposed amendment involves no significant hazards considerations.

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 170.21, we have determined that the application fee is \$150. A remittance of \$150 is attached to this letter.
