1. ANO-2 SEISMIC ACTIVITY

There has been news media interest in seismic activities which occurred on 1/20/82 about 60 miles east/north east of the ANO plants. The disturbances occurred about 6:00 PM, measured 4.5 on the Richter Scale and were not generally noticed in the plant site area.

The seismic monitoring equipment at ANO, which is set to record above 0.01 g, was not activated. Operability of the equipment was confirmed by plant staff after the event. The site SSE and OBE values are 0.20 g and 0.10 g.
