Office of State Programs has become aware of a letter dated January 26, 1982 to DOE Secretary Edwards from Senator McClure, Chairman of the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee. In his letter, Senator McClure asks DOE to provide detailed responses within 120 days to questions relating to the progress being made by states to enter into regional compacts for low-level waste disposal under the Low-Level Radioactive Waste Policy Act of 1980. DOE is asked to supply copies of comments concerning compacts by any government agency and to consult with government agencies (NRC is specifically named) in responding to the Senator's request. The NRC staff has commented, or is preparing comments, on regional compacts or draft regional compacts for the Northwest, Southeast, Rocky Mountain, South Central and Midwest regions.

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
