Gentlemen:

As required by 10CFR50, Appendix H, please find attached WCAP 11726, "Analysis of Capsule V from the South Carolina Electric & Gas Company Virgil C. Summer Unit 1 Reactor Vessel Radiation Surveillance Program." This report reflects the results of tests performed on Capsule V which was withdrawn from the reactor vessel during the third refueling outage at the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station. In summary, the results indicate that the reactor vessel material exhibits a more than adequate upper shelf energy level for continued safe plant operation throughout the vessel life as required by 10CFR50, Appendix G. Also a low risk of vessel failure from pressurized thermal shock events is expected.

No specific Technical Specification changes are required to incorporate the results of this surveillance inspection; however, in accordance with the requirements of Generic Letter 88-11, future changes to the heatup/cooldown curves are expected. These Technical Specification changes will be submitted pursuant to the requirements of the Generic Letter.
