Subject: PLANT SHUTDOWN DUE TO INOPERABLE ISOLATION CONDENSERS (EVENT No. 1255)

At 1:20 p.m. today (9/29/88) the licensee notified the NRC operations center that they were to commence an orderly shutdown of the reactor. This was as a result of the licensee's review of data which indicated that the steam lines for both "A" and "B" Isolation Condensers were partially filled with water placing the steam lines in a potential inoperable condition. The licensee and Region I staff are reviewing the data to identify the cause of this situation.

During the shutdown, the licensee disabled the automatic initiation system for the condenser isolation valves to prevent possible water hammer in case of inadvertent actuation. The licensee declared an Unusual Event at 2:30 p.m.

Region I plans to respond to media inquires. The State of New Jersey was informed.
