This is to confirm arrangements made during a telephone conversation between Mr. M. McBurnett of your staff and Region IV staff on September 19, 1988, to reschedule an Enforcement Conference originally scheduled for September 15, 1988, at 9 a.m. (CDT). The purpose of the Enforcement Conference is to discuss an apparent violation regarding improper fire watches as documented in NRC Investigation Report No. 4-88-004, and an apparent violation regarding a failure to include appropriate acceptance criteria in closing out a maintenance work request as documented in NRC Inspection Report 50-498/88-46. The referenced investigation report synopsis and inspection report were forwarded to you under separate cover. A proposed meeting agenda is enclosed.
