

Technical Specification Change Request No. 174

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90, GPU Nuclear Corporation, owner and operator of the Cyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station, requests a change to Appendix A of its operating license.

The requested change would allow removing the High Pressure Scram function when the reactor head is removed or unbolted. This change is necessary to install new analog pressure sensors during the upcoming refueling cutage (12R).

As presently scheduled, the analog sensor installation will not be completed when low power physics testing commences. These two evolutions will be conducted simultaneously. As the analog sensor replacement is already in the critical maintenance load path, rescheduling the low power physics testing would extend the refueling outage unnecessarily. To support the timely completion of the outage, it is requested that, if approved, this change be issued effective November 15, 1988.
