Florida Power Corporation (FPC) is submitting this letter in response to the NRC letter dated April 29, 1988 [S. A. Varga (NRC) to W. S. Wilgus (FPC)].

The B&W Owner's Group is using the Recommendation Tracking System (RTS) Report as the vehicle to transmit the utility's status, and schedule for implementation of the Safety and Performance Improvement Program (SPIP) recommendations. The latest RTS report was transmitted by Mr. N.A. Rutherford's letter OG-197, dated May 10, 1988 to Mr. D.N. Crutchfield. The plant specific information for Crystal River Unit 3 is contained in the RTS. Changes to our implementation status will be submitted to the B&WOG for inclusion in updates to the RTS.
