SUBJECT: AMENDMENT REQUESTS IN-HOUSE

A survey was conducted of all project managers with operating reactors to determine the number of amendments either in-house or expected to be in-house by May 6, 1983. The raw data sheets are attached. However, a basic summary is as follows:

It is noted that these numbers do not include Fort St. Vrain. Fort St. Vrain is a demonstration reactor and there is some question as to whether or not it is applicable to the Sholly decision. However, Fort St. Vrain has eight amendments in-house, expects to receive four more by May 6, will complete none of the amendments by May 6, and has no hearing requests.

Attached is also a package describing the request for a hearing concerning the steam generator repairs at TMI-1.
