Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. 9. H. Harrell, T. Reis, and R. P. Mullikin of this office during the period April 1-30, 1988, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License DPR-40 for the Fort Calhoun Station, and to the discussion of our findings with you and other members of your staff at thconclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included followup on previously identified items, licensee event report followup, operational safety verification, plant tours, safety-related system walkdown, monthly maintenance observations, monthly surveillance observations, security observations, radiological protection observations, in-office review of periodic and special reports, followup on the licensee's program for sampling the emergency diesel generator fuel oil supplies, followup on NUREG-0737 (TMI) Item II.K.3.5 concerning tripping of reactor coolant pumps after a loss-of-coolant accident and followup on the potential for inadvertent dilution of the reactor coolant system via the sodium hydroxide tank. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the NRC inspectors. The inspection findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this violation, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclused with this letter.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report.

The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice is not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
