PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT I AM IN FAVOR OF THE NEW RULE THAT WOULD CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENTS NEW NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS MUST MEET BEFORE LOW POWER TESTING. THIS RULE AND ITS INTERPRETATION, WILL, AS I UNDERSTAND IT, CLARIFY SOME AMBIGUITY IN THE EXISTING RULE. THIS AMBIGUITY IS BEING EXPLOITED BY OPPONENTS OF SEABROOK WHO ARE HOPING ONCE AGAIN TO DELAY OR CANCEL SEABROOK STATION. I AM, QUITE FRANKLY, TIRED OF THESE TACTICS BY ANTI-NUCLEAR ACTIVISTS AND THEIR SELFISH MOTIVES. POWER IS NEEDED IN THE REGION AND THEY HAVE SUGGESTED NO FEASIBLE ALTERNATIVES. NOR, ESPECIALLY, HAVE THEY ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT ANY OF THEIR MINDLESS ALTERNATIVES.

PLEASE ENACT THE PROPOSED RULE TO PREVENT ANY FURTHER, SENSELESS DELAY TO THE OPENING OF SEABROOK STATION.
