Subject: Completion of NRC Generic Letter 96-01 Actions

Generic Letter 96-01 (Reference 2) requested that addressees perform comparisons of specified plant logic and schematic drawings against plant surveillance test procedures to ensure that all portions of the specified logic circuitry are adequately covered in the surveillance procedures. The Generic Letter also requested that surveillance procedures be modified as necessary for complete testing to comply with the Technical Specifications. Detroit Edison's initial response (Reference 3) to this Generic Letter indicated that the requested actions had been completed in the course of correcting self-identified testing deficiencies.


Generic Letter 96-01 acknowledged that licensees may have performed the requested reviews. For these licensees, the Generic Letter suggested that any modifications made to these logic circuits should be reviewed. Detroit Edison described its plans for additional reviews and actions intended to ensure that the affected logic circuits remain adequately covered by surveillance test procedures. These additional reviews and actions have been performed, thereby completing all necessary actions for Generic Letter 96-01.




