Gentlemen:

Reference (a) was submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(6)(i), requesting schedule relief from an ASME Code Section XI requirement. This letter revises our previous submittal and requests relief in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55a(a)(3), proposing an alternative to an ASME Code Section XI reporting schedule.

We are processing a 30-day extension for submitting Form NIS-2, from October 2, 1988, to November 1, 1968. Compliance with the October 2 deadline would result in hardship or unusual difficulties without a compensating increase in the level of quality and safety. As discussed in Reference (a), the preparation of this form is time consuming due to the number of jobs performed.
