On October 6-9, 1998, the NRC staff conducted an audit of the Year 2000 (Y2K) program at the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant Units 1 and 2 as a followup to NRC Generic Letter (GL) 98-01, "Year 2000 Readiness of Computer Systems at Nuclear Power Plants," issued on May 11, 1998. The enclosed report presents the results of the audit. The results of this audit and subsequent audits at other selected nuclear power plants will be used by the staff to determine the need for additional action, if any, on Y2K readiness for nuclear power plants.
